

SANTA FE MATCHLESS STAR

54" x 54"

This is made with scrap strips. You need enough random width strips to construct four 9 1/2" X 44" strip sets, plus some extra pieces for the 2" and 3" cornerstones. Strips should vary 1" to 3" in width.

Or 1 Jelly Roll

Or 2 1/2" strip set with at least 32 strips

1 1/2 yards background fabric

2/3 yard contrasting fabric for small borders

2 1/2 yards for backing

batting

freezer paper

This is an easy version of a Lone Star. Using random width strips eliminates the need for matching the diamond pieces.

Preclass Work:

32 pieces of jelly roll can be used. Must be width of fabric (42-45")

7 strips at 2 1/4"

6 strips at 2"

6 strips at 1 3/4"

6 strips at 1 1/2"

6 strips at 1 1/4"
